# PAYNES PRAIRIE PRESERVE



**P**aynes Prairie Preserve State Park is listed on the National Register of Natural Landmarks and is recognized as one of the most significant geological, natural and cultural areas in Florida. The 21,000 acres includes a Visitor Center, cycling, walking, equestrian trails, camping, picnicking and boat ramp access to Lake Wauberg.

The preserve is known for its outstanding wildlife viewing including: alligators, sandhill cranes, bison, cracker horses, cattle and over 270 bird species. To take the cell phone tour, visit the park and follow this brochure for tour stops.

**To visit:** Paynes Prairie Preserve State Park is located 10 miles south of Gainesville. Travel east on University Avenue to US 441. Make a right on US 441. Approximately 10 miles and is on the east side of US 441. Paynes Prairie Visitor Center GPS 29° 31' 10.2" N 82° 17' 52.3" W. Admission Fee: \$5 per vehicle. Limit 2-8 people per vehicle.
