



FY24 ADDENDUM 2 Final: August 11, 2023

Question: Last year we were able to use the average of 2018 and 2019, the two FYs pre-COVID. In 2022, we were still seeing residual effects from COVID (very slow return of large group tours). Which fiscal years can we use for the calculation of average attendance for this grant cycle?

Answer: Please use the grant application criteria: Average attendance from the two most recent previous years of normal operations.

Question: We just received our 501c3 status this year. In years prior, we have filled out the Form F-1102. We have not done a 990 yet. We will for this year. How should we fill out the form in regards to request for funding? I am not sure how much we are eligible for funding.

Answer: If you have not yet filed the 990 or 990N, provide a statement of revenues and expenses for the most recently completed fiscal year. The statement of revenues and expenses must be approved by the organization's board of directors. A detailed project / event budget for the special event or activity must also be provided. Please note on the application that you have not yet filed a 990 for your organization.

Question: We did not file 990 last year. So how can we provide our budget?

Answer: If you have not yet filed the 990 or 990N, provide a statement of revenues and expenses for the most recently completed fiscal year. The statement of revenues and expenses must be approved by the organization's board of directors. A detailed project / event budget for the special event or activity must also be provided. Please note on the application that you have not yet filed a 990 for your organization.

Question: Is attending shows such as big gift or craft shows qualified for applying the application?

Answer: This application funds events and activities in Alachua County that are open to the public and advertised to visitors from outside the county. There is no funding available to attend an event or craft show.



Question: Could we hold or attend the event out of the country?

Answer: No. The operations, events and activities must be within the boundaries of Alachua County.

Question: I am typing all our grant information into the word document. It is protected. Is there a way to delete the extra lines?

Answer: The Nature and Culture Destination Enhancement Grant document has been updated and is on the website. If you have already completed the previous document, that format is acceptable.
